## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: This product may only be used to control pocket gophers (*Geomys spp., Thomomys spp., and Pappogeomys spp.*) in subterranean applications only in rangelands, pastures, croplands, and no-crop areas. Do not apply this product by use of a mechanical burrow builder. Do not apply this product above ground over agricultural crops or anywhere else. Do not apply directly to food or feed crops.

BAITING: Remove burrow plug from flat side of the burrow fan or locate the main runway by probing with a metal rod or wooden stick. Resistance on the probe will decrease when you are in the main runway. Insert one tablespoon of bait into the burrow system, using a long-handled spoon if necessary. Close the tunnel with soil. Do not permit soil to cover the bait, One pound of bait will treat 1-8 acres, depending on the number of burrow systems to be treated. Retreat according to above directions if new gopher activity is noticed.

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Peseticide Storage: Store in original container in a dry place. Store in a locked area out of reach of children.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spilled bait, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**Container Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Empty container through use according to label instructions. Then dispose of container in a sanitary landfill or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.



#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Convulsive Poison1 Poisonous if swallowed. Do not breath dust, Do not contaminate feed and food stuffs. Keep away from children, pets and domestic animals.
