The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

TO CONTROL POULTRY LICE: Spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist.

TO CONTROL BEDBUGS AND MITES IN POULTRY HOUSES: Spray crevices of roosts poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where the bedbugs and mites hide.
