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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Causes moderate eye irritation. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not contaminate food or feed products.

Malathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use this product simultaneously with other drugs, insecticides, pesticides or chemicals having cholinesterase inhibiting activity nor within a few days before or after treating with Malathion.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates and aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in areas near the application site. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply if bees are visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. For outdoor use around the home only.

Fly Control: For outdoor use only, mix 2 ¼ qts. per 100 gals. of water. Spray on walls, fences, garbage containers, and wherever flies congregate and breed. Wet all surfaces thoroughly. The addition of 8 Tbsp. of sugar per gal. will extend the life of the bait residue.

Peaches: For control of Spider Mites, Mealy Bugs, Wooly Aphids, Japanese Beetles (adults) and Oriental Fruit Moths, use 1 ½ to 2 Tbsp. of 50% MALATHION CONCENTRATE to 1 gal. water. For Oriental Fruit Moths, apply at petal fall and every 10 to 14 days thereafter until control is achieved. Apply as needed for other pests. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

Pecan Trees: For control of Pecan Nut Casebearers, Pecan Phylloxeras, Pecan Budmoths, Spider Mites and Aphids, use 2 Tbsp. of 50% MALATHION CONCENTRATE to 1 gal. of water.

Ornamentals: (Roses, Camellias, Azaleas, Chrysanthemums, Evergreens and many other flowers and shrubs) For control of Aphids, Birch Leaf Miners, Japanese Beetles (adults), Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Mealy Bugs, Tarnished Plant Bugs, Thrips and Whiteflies, use 1 tsp. per gal. of water. For control of Bagworms, Tent Caterpillars, Black Scale Crawlers, Leaf Scale, Oyster Shell Scale, Soft Brown Scale, and Spider mites, use 2 tsp. per gal. of water. Do not use on certain ferns, including Boston, Maidenbair and Pteris, as well as some species of Crassula.

Vegetables: For Aphids and Spider mites on Tomatoes and Cucumbers; Aphids, Leafhoppers and @ Mealy Bugs on Potatoes: Mexican Bean Beetles, Leafhoppers and Spider Mites on Beans: Aphids on @ Peppers, Cabbage and Broccoli, use on 1 tsp. per gal. of water. For control of Onion Thrips on Onions, use 2 tsp. per gal. of water.

DO NOT USE later than 3 days before harvest on the above vegetables with the exception of Cabbage, and this should not be applied later than 7 days before harvest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage

Do not store below 10°F (-12°).

Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use replace lids and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides fertilizers, water food, or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill; avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills

Tro confine spill affiliquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay affiding material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container aldentify contents.

Pesticide Disposal

Pesticide wastes are toxic: Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions; contact your State Pesticide of Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative of the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal

Nonrefillable Metal or Plastic Container (5 Gallon or less). Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying "Triple rinse as follows: Empty, the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds Pour rinsate into application equipment or a tank or store for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities. Democratical metals containers.
