Do not graze or feed lawn or sod clippings to livestock.

This formula contains a special blend of foods, combined with the delayed-action stomach poison, hydramethylnon. This product is specially formulated to allow time for worker ants that find the bait to carry it back to the queen and other ants before dying. This product kills the queen and the colony. Do not apply other insecticides (such as sprays, dusts or granules, etc.) on top of or in close proximity to this product, as it will reduce its effectiveness.
