READY TO USE - No dilution necessary.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pour along back line and down face. Apply ½ fl. oz. per 100 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 5 fl. ozs. for any one animal to control Lice, Horn Flies and Face Flies. Aids in control of Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes, Black Flies and Ticks on lactating and non-lactating dairy cattle, beef cattle, calves and sheep.

For Keds on sheep, pour along back line over neck, shoulders and rump. Apply ¼ fl. oz. per 50 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 3 fl. ozs. for any one animal.

Repeat treatment as needed, but do not exceed 5 fl. ozs. during any 14 day interval. For optimum lice control, two treatments at a 14 day interval are recommended.

NOTE: This product is not effective for grub control on cattle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage and Spill Procedures: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. Store in a locked area out of reach of children and domestic animals. In case of spillage or leakages, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, Fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.
