APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Pour along back line and down face. Apply ½ fl. oz. per 100 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 5 fl. ozs. for any one animal to control Lice, Horn Flies and Face Flies. Aids in control of Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes, Black Flies and Ticks on lactating and non-lactating dairy cattle, beef cattle, calves and sheep.

For Keds on sheep, pour along back line over neck, shoulders and rump. Apply ¼ fl. oz. per 50 lbs. body weight of animal, up to a maximum of 3 fl. ozs. for any one animal.

Repeat treatment as needed, but do not exceed 5 fl. ozs. during any 14 day interval. For optimum lice control, two treatments at a 14 day interval are recommended.

NOTE: This product is not effective for grub control on cattle.

Restrictions:

Do not apply this product that will contact workers or other persons either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

When used in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk bulk tank lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking.
