
- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, EPA Reg. No. **53883-105**.

- c. All references to “Destroys the Entire Ant Colony” must be removed from the labeling. This claim requires the submission and/or citation of efficacy data.
- d. Under the Storage and Disposal statements revise the “**If empty**” statement to read as follows:

**“If Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
If Partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP which is managed as a public-private partnership.**

- e. Under the **Directions for Use** add the statement:
“Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas while food is exposed”.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Place the bait on dry surfaces at any angle, out of traffic ways, where ants are seen and in areas, out of reach of children and pets. Children or pets should not be in the treatment area until after application is completed.

- Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.
- Place baits in areas inaccessible to children and pets.
- Remove as many competing food sources as practical.
- Wash hands thoroughly before handling to remove any odors that may be repellent to ants, such as tobacco, garlic, chemicals, cleaners, etc.
- Do not use sprays, foggers, chemicals or cleaners near bait placements. This may contaminate the bait and cause insect to cease feeding.

Use 1 to 3 lines for each placement. Place baits under food cabinets, sinks, stoves, refrigerators, food storage areas, attics, garages, basements, storage areas, closets, etc. Place on exterior windowsills and in doorways to help prevent entry of ants. **Ant Gel Bait** may be placed in commercially available insect bait stations as conditions warrant.

Ants are attracted to and will feed on **Ant Gel Bait** until they die. The ants will return to their nests after consuming the bait and will feed their young and the queen destroying the colony. Repeat treatment of the bait until satisfactory control has been achieved. bathrooms, or storage areas. Replace the applicator "cap" after use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
