In New York State, do make a single repeat application of Bifenthrin 0.1% Lawn Granules if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application.

Apply when insect activity or damage is first observed in the lawn (lawn thins and turns brown or moths fly from the grass when you mow). Don't treat just the browned area of lawn. To prevent further damage, treat entire lawn.

Surface Feeding Lawn Insects Use Bifen Lawn & Perimeter for the control of ants, including Carpenter, Red Harvester, Odorous Pyramid, Pharaoh (Sugar) Ants, Armyworms (including Fall Armyworms), Billbug (Including Bluegrass Billbug), Chiggers, Chinch Bugs, Crickets, Cutworms (including Black Cutworms), Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Mealybugs, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth), and Weevils (including Hyperodes and Bluegrass). Uniformly apply 2.4 pounds over a 1,000 sq. ft. area of lawn. Argentine Ants, Black Turf Ants, Black Turfgrass Ataenius, Fleas (including Cat Water thoroughly immediately after application. Fleas), Leafhoppers, Spiders (including Brown Recluse Spiders) and Ticks (including Brown Dog Ticks) Centipedes, Millipedes, Pavement Ants, Uniformly apply 4.8 pounds over a 1,000 sq. ft. area of lawn. Mole Crickets (including Tawny Mole For mole crickets, treat in late spring. Water thoroughly
