2. On page three, secondary paragraph of "Soil Incorporation Application change the rate to read 1/3 lb. (5.0 oz). This is the rate reflected on the parent label.

3. Submit to the Agency the required one year storage stability (830.6317) study for the proposed product under warehouse conditions. The corrosion characteristics (830.6320) study may be carried out concurrently. It is recommended that observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months.

4. Under the warranty statement rewrite "**To the extent allowed by law**" to read as "**To the extent consistent with applicable law...**"

5. Submit two copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitute acceptance of these conditions.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

IMI Termite G is a ready-to-use product and, when used as directed, will aid in the control of the following termite species: *Coptotermes*, *Heterotermes*, *Reticulitermes*, and *Zootermopsis*.

IMI Termite G may be applied as directed to bare soils, landscape areas and turfgrass immediately surrounding commercial and residential structures, as well as other wooden constructions where the threat of termite attack exists.

IMI Termite G may be applied as a broadcast application and/or soil incorporation application. When applied to the soil with sufficient rainfall and/or soil moisture, the active ingredient is released from the granule carrier and carries into the upper layers of soil where termites are most active.

**NOTE:** IMI Termite G is not intended to be used as the only treatment for control of active structural infestations by subterranean termites; it is not a substitute for mechanical alteration, soil and foundation treatments.

IMI Termite G is for use in addition to soil applied termiticides, termite bait systems or other products registered as a sole source for control of active termite infestations.

**USE RESTRICTIONS**

- Do not apply when areas are waterlogged or when the soil is saturated with water. Adequate distribution of the active ingredient into the soil cannot be achieved when these conditions are present and optimum control will not be possible.
- Do not allow runoff or puddling of irrigation water following applications.
- Do not apply more than 80 lb. of IMI Termite G (0.4 lb. of active ingredient) per acre per year.
- Do not plant, for the purpose of consumption, edible plants into areas where applications of IMI Termite G have been made.

Food utensils such as teaspoons and measuring cups should not be used for food purposes after use with this insecticide.

Avoid contamination of public and private water supplies.

### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

**Perimeter Band Application:** For broadcast application in commercial and residential areas. To kill subterranean termites, apply IMI Termite G at a rate of 1.8 lb. (29 oz.) of per 1,000 sq. ft. Treat a band around the perimeter of the structure 3 to 10 feet wide. For optimum control, follow application with sufficient irrigation (or rainfall) to move the active ingredient in the granule through groundcover and thatch layer of turfgrass to the top layers of soil where the termites are active.

Apply IMI Termite G with standard properly calibrated granular application equipment (e.g. hand-held spreaders, shaker cans, or wheel-mounted spreaders). Calibrate application equipment prior to use according to the manufacturer's directions and inspect frequently to be sure the equipment is working properly and distributing granules uniformly and accurately.

**Soil Incorporation Application:** IMI Termite G can be used to kill termites in the soil that may be present at the time of treatment. Incorporate IMI Termite G into the soil along and around the foundations of commercial and residential structures. IMI Termite G may also be incorporated into soils around other wood structures where termite infestations may occur. For best results dig a narrow trench (approx 6" X 6") adjacent to the structure and evenly incorporate up to 1/6 lb. (2.7 oz.) of IMI Termite G per linear foot of trench. When refilling the trench, thoroughly incorporate this product with the soil that will be used to refill trench.

IMI Termite G may also be used to provide a chemically treated area at and around other crucial areas (i.e. around plumbing, bath traps, utility services, wells and cisterns, around poles or posts, fencing and decking materials, landscape timbers and other locations where non-structural wood-to-soil contacts occur) at a rate of 1/3 lb. (5.4 oz.) of product per sq. ft. of surface.

NOTE: 1 level cup is approximately 8.5 oz. of IMI Termite G.

**Spot Treatment:** As a temporary control measure only, IMI Termite G may be used as a spot treatment before the final treatment with conventional soil and foundation treatment of the structure is completed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store this product in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If material is spilled for any reason or cause, carefully contain any spilled material to prevent non-target contamination. Do not walk through spilled material and dispose of as directed for pesticides below. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
