IMI 0.22 G Rose, Flower & Shrub Insecticide works inside the plant, so rain and water will not wash off the insect protection.

IMI 0.22 G Rose, Flower & Shrub Insecticide kills Adelgids, Aphids, Fungus gnats, Leafminers, Lace bugs, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Plant bugs, Psyllids, Soft Scales, Thrips (suppression), Whiteflies, and other listed pests. Apply every 8 weeks during the growing season to roses, flowers and shrubs. 2 lbs. treats up to 16 medium-size roses or shrubs.

#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

For new plants, apply when planting. For established plants, use before pest damage occurs or immediately when seen. Repeat applications every 8 weeks during the growing season.

#### **HOW MUCH TO APPLY**

Fill measuring cap to top of inner circle (2 oz.) Four rounded tablespoons equals 2 oz.

For Roses: 1 capful (2 oz.) per plant

For Shrubs: 2 capfuls (4 oz.) per foot of plant height

For Flower Beds: 1 capful (2 oz.) per 50 sq ft (5'x10' bed area)

Apply the required amount of granules evenly on top of soil, mix thoroughly into the top soil layer, being careful not to damage the upper roots, then water in thoroughly. For flower beds, sprinkle granules evenly over bed.
