General Information

Bifen 0.086 G Lawn Insecticide with Fertilizer is a summer lawn fertilizer and insecticide for the control of chinch bugs, sod webworms (lawn moth), fleas, ticks (including ticks that may transmit Lyme Disease), and other lawn pests listed on this label.

Application Instructions

Apply Bifen 0.086 G Lawn Insecticide with Fertilizer to the entire lawn when insect activity or damage is first observed. Apply to a dry lawn. Spread granules uniformly over the lawn following the spreader settings in the table below. After application, water lawn to release the product into the soil. A single, repeat application of Bifen 0.086 G Lawn Insecticide with Fertilizer may be made if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than 2 weeks after the first application.

Use Precautions

- Do not use any other weed, disease, or insect control products for at least one week after application.
- In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area (lawns) within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, steam, wetland, or drainage ditch).
- Do not make a repeat application sooner than 2 weeks after the first application.
