


5. Add the following statement under the "First Aid" section: "Hot Line Number" "Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency treatment information."

6. Under the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section, revise the statement to read: "Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin, or if inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

7. Fix the typo in the "Warranty Statement" (delete an extra "period" and "a") so that the phrase reads "...product. To the extent..."

8. Generate one year storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics (830.6317) studies within one year of the date of this registration notice.

9. Submit one copy of the revised label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Dithiopyr Concentrate for Fertilizer is for use only as an additive for formulation of herbicide fertilizer blends registered by US EPA containing dithiopyr herbicide. Do not apply dithiopyr Concentrate for Fertilizer directly to any growing plants.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If material is spilled for any reason or cause, carefully contain any spilled material to prevent non-target contamination. Do not walk through spilled material and dispose of as directed for pesticides above. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.

This product is intended to be blended with fertilizer to deliver a rate of up to 0.057 lb of dithiopyr a.i. per 5000 square feet of lawn (0.5 lbs dithiopyr a.i per acre). In this case (equivalent to 0.25%), each 6000 lb batch of fertilizer would require 72 lb of Dithiopyr Concentrate for Fertilizer. Use 3 to 4% white oil or propylene glycol to aid binding of Dithiopyr Concentrate for Fertilizer to the fertilizer, and to minimize dust. Refer to the specific directions for blending each variety of registered herbicide fertilizer blend.

When blended with fertilizer, dithiopyr may be applied to the following plants:

Cool season turf:

creeping bluegrass, Kentucky bluegrass, fine fescue, tall fescue, perennial ryegrass

Warm season turf:

Bahiagrass, Bermudagrass, buffalograss, carpetgrass, centipedegrass, Kikuyugrass, St. Augustinegrass, Zoysiagrass

Most shrubs and trees. Specific regional use directions for each application type must be listed on the separately-registered fertilizer blend label.

Weeds controlled may include the following:

Grasses

Crabgrass - large, smooth, and southern species; barley; barnyardgrass; bromegrass; crowfootgrass; dallisgrass (seedling); Foxtail (yellow and green); goosegrass; Kikuyugrass; wild oats; annual and perennial ryegrass; smutgrass.

Broadleaf weeds

Bittercress; carpetweed; chickweed; Carolina geranium; henbit; prostrate knotweed; common lespedeza; maretail; black medic; mustard; buttercup; parsley-piert (suppression only); redroot pigweed; pineappleweed;; common purslane; London rocket; shepherdspurge; corn speedwell; garden spurge; prostrate spurge; spotted spurge; woodsorrel (creeping, yellow).
