The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended is acceptable subject to the comments listed below Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records

1 Revise the Precautionary Statement to read as follows

Harmful if absorbed through skin Avoid contact with skin eyes or clothing Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating drinking chewing gum using tobacco or using the toilet Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse

2 Revise the Environmental Hazards section to read as follows

This product is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. To protect the environment do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains drainage ditches gutter or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Sweeping any product that lands on a driveway sidewalk or street back onto the treated area of the lawn or garden will help to prevent run off to water bodies or drainage systems.

3 Replace the optional marketing claim Kills [Fire Ants] on Contact] with Kills [Fire Ants] by Contact]

4 Under section Broadcast Treatment revise the last sentence to read as follows

For best control of foraging workers and newly mated fly in queens use both broadcast applications and mound treatments that will control existing colonies

5 Delete the following Optional Marketing Claims

Prevents [protects against] fire ants for an entire season
One application provides season long control
Season long control [protection]
Prevents fire ants for an entire season
Protects [your lawn] for entire season
Last all season
1 application controls fire ants for the entire season

Revise the following Optional Marketing Claims as follows

Replace Prevents Fire Ant Mound formation with Controls Fire Ant Mound formation

Replace Prevents new Fire Ant mounds from forming for up to 6 months with Controls new Fire Ant mounds from forming for up to 6 months Replace Prevents fire ants for [1 2 3 4 5] 6 months with Controls fire ants for [1 2 3 4 5] 6 months

If these conditions are not complied with the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec 6(e) Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

Restrictions

- In New York State this product may not be applied to any grass or turf area within 100 feet of a water body (lake pond river stream wetland or drainage ditch)
- In New York State do make a single repeat application of Fire Ant Killer if there are signs of renewed insect activity but not sooner than two (2) weeks after the first application

WHERE TO USE

Fire Ant Killer is for use to kill Fire Ants (including Argentine Odorous Pyramid Pavement and Red Harvester) on residential lawns only Applications may be made as broadcast or as individual mound treatments

FOR MOUND TREATMENT

HOW TO USE

Make applications in the early morning or late evening hours when it is cool and the ants are most active. Apply when temperatures are between 65 and 80 F

HOW TO APPLY

Treat mound and an area 4 ft in diameter around the mound Apply % cup of Fire Ant Killer over each fire ant mound Irrigate the soil before application if it is dry After application apply 1 to 2 gallons of water over each mound

NOTE Food utensils such as teaspoons and measuring cups must not be used for food purposes after use with pesticides

FOR BROADCAST TREATMENT

HOW TO USE

Apply during the morning or late evening when it is cool and the ants are most active Treat the entire lawn area to prevent reinfestation of fire ants from neighboring areas For best control of foraging workers and newly mated fly in queens use both broadcast applications and mound treatments that will kill existing colonies

HOW TO APPLY

Apply uniformly over your lawn using the suggested spreader settings. Water lawn after application to wash granules from the lawn foliage. Irrigate the soil before application if it is dry

NOTE People and pets may enter treated areas after granules have been watered in and the treated area has dried
