- 2. In order to incorporate required label language from the RED for piperonyl butoxide, revise the listing of "Technical Piperonyl Butoxide*" to read "Piperonyl Butoxide*" and revise the 1st footnote to read "**(butylcarbityl) (6-polypiperonyl) ether and related compounds."

First Aid section comment(s):

- 3. To facilitate inclusion of required label changes from the acute toxicity review that was completed for the cited product (EPA Reg. No. 655-113), you must incorporate the following changes to the subject label:
 - Within the "If swallowed" subsection, revise the 1st bulleted statement to read "Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice."


