

Treat the nest until thoroughly wet. Contact wasps and hornets on the nest with spray when possible. The best time of day to treat is in evening or early morning, since wasps and hornets congregate on or in the nest at night.

YELLOWJACKETS AND BEES: Locate nest. Align [nozzle valve][value actuator] opening directly opposite the mark on the valve cup. Press down on the actuator and apply, using a sweeping motion, contacting any stimulated or stirred-up yellowjackets and bees around the nest opening. Then move forward to the nest opening and apply for 6 - 8 sec directly into the nest hole.

SPIDERS (including Black Widow and Brown Recluse): Apply directly to spiders and/or webbing. Before
