**FOR SPAS AND HOT TUBS**  
1. Chlorinate: Add 1 oz. SPA GRANULES per 500 gallons of water to the water prior to entering the spa. Wait 5 minutes then check chlorine residual. Residual chlorine must be read between 2 to 3 ppm. If it does not, additional dosages of material should be added until it does. Once the chlorine residual is established in the 2 to 3 ppm range, the pool may be entered.  
2. Maintain: SPA GRANULES should be added daily or as necessary to maintain 2 to 3 ppm residual chlorine. Frequent checks should be made of residual chlorine using a reliable test kit. The SPA GRANULES should be broadcast over the surface of the water and allowed at least 5 minutes mix time before swimming.

Note: Heavy bather usage or the use of oils or lotions may increase the chlorine residual.

3. Check pH: pH should be maintained in the 7.2 to 7.6 range. pH can be decreased by bisulphate or increased by soda ash. Instructions on side panel.  
4. Superchlorination: Add 1/2 oz. SPA GRANULES for each spa, vacuum and cycle chlorine residual to 10 ppm.

5. If a good practice is to add superchlorinate, add residual chlorine falls below 2.5 SPA GRANULES. If not, it is used required will be required.

6. SPA GRANULES are not flammable and SPA GRANULES can be used with liquid chlorine. It contains a high strength dry product. SPA GRANULES reduce chlorine loss on materials which can be the sides of the pool.

7. Keep product dry and Store in cool dry well ventilated area. Do not use and flush with large volume of water. Discard in approved landfill area.

8. Seller warrants that description on the label is accurate and under normal conditions the use of the product will not cause any conditions foreseeable to Seller. Seller disclaims including any warranty.
