The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Three (3) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

1. The declaration **ACTIVE INGREDIENTS** should be of the same type size as the declaration Inert Ingredients. Both declarations should either be printed in normal or bold print, at your discretion, but not both.

2. Delete the following statement from the product label: May be mixed with food-grade insect attractants.

3. Include the following text to the paragraph titled **As spray for ants, roaches, and silverfish:**

Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

4. The term **CAUTION** which appears in the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** section of the product label should follow, rather than precede, the phrase **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**, such that the headings appear as shown below:

Directions for Use: *It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.*

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants or on counter tops and other surface areas where food is prepared. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Mixing and Application Directions:

1. Mop-on for Cockroach and silverfish

Add one cup of powder (4 oz.) to each pail (5 gal.) of mop or rinse water. Dissolves instantly in water. **Apply to floor areas only.** Make only enough for each application. Designed for use as a supplemental treatment to exterminating service or to M5 Roach Kill. **Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.** Use daily in areas with severe infestation. In normal use, apply daily for 10-15 days and then every other day thereafter to maintain residual. If use is discontinued for a week, use daily for 10 days thereafter to rebuild residual.

Food areas and Food Serving Areas: Apply only when food is not exposed and facility is not in operation. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food.

2. As spray for ants, roaches and silverfish

Mix one scoop (4 oz.) per gallon of warm water. Using sprayer or trigger sprayer spray behind and under refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, grills, stovetops, washing machine, drier and other appliances and in cracks and crevices and particularly in hidden areas with food films, grease and debris. Do not spray on food preparation surfaces. May be mixed with food grade insect attractants.

Mixing and Application Directions (Flea):

For use in carpet cleaning equipment (extractors/shampoos): May be used along with detergent. Mix one scoop (4 oz.) per gallon of water. Clean carpet as directed by equipment manufacturer. Use one gallon of mixture per 75-120 square feet of carpet.

Vacuum carpet, furniture, baseboards, pet bedding and other flea harborages before applying as a spray or dry powder. Immediately seal vacuum bag and place in trash.

For use as a spray on carpet and other floor areas:

Mix 12 oz. (three scoops) per 1 gallon hot water. Best time to treat is immediately after shampooing. Spray evenly at a rate of 1 gallon per 200 sq. feet of carpet. If needed, broom or rake so spray penetrates to base of carpet. Spray lightly on baseboards, tile, concrete or dirt floors.

For use as a dry powder on carpeting, furniture wells, and baseboards: Dust 8 oz. per 100 sq. ft. of carpet and broom in to base of carpet fibers. Using a Pest Pistol bellows duster, dust lightly into furniture wells and into cracks and crevices. Wait 48 hours before vacuuming.
