Directions for Use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants or on counter tops and other surface areas where food is prepared. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Mixing and Application Directions (Cockroach):

Add one cup of powder (4 oz.) to each pail (5 gal.) of mop or rinse water. M7 roach killer dissolves instantly in water. **Apply to floor areas only.** Make only enough for each application. Designed for use as a supplemental treatment to exterminating service or to M5 Roach Kill. **Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.** Use daily in areas with severe infestation. In normal use, apply daily for 10-15 days and then every other day thereafter to maintain residual. If use is discontinued for a week, use daily for 10 days thereafter to rebuild residual.

Food areas and Food Serving Areas:

Apply only when food is not exposed and facility is not in operation. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food.

Mixing and Application Directions (Flea):

Apply with carpet cleaning equipment (extractors/shampooers). May be used along with detergent. Mix one scoop (4oz. net weight) with each gallon of water. Clean carpet as directed by equipment manufacturer. Use one gallon of mixture per 75-120 square feet of carpet.
