

**DIRECTIONS FOR CHLORINATION:**  
 For a new pool or for spring start-up, add this sodium hypochlorite solution to the pool water until the available chlorine is 5 ppm.

**For Pool Maintenance:**  
 A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6. B) Add manually or by a feeder. Maintain an available chlorine of 1.0 ppm available chlorine by adding this sodium hypochlorite solution until the available chlorine is 1.0 ppm available chlorine will be maintained. Use test kit to make certain.

**DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING:**  
 Dilute this sodium hypochlorite solution to 9 parts softened water to 1 part product. Thoroughly scrub and begin feeding of solution and begin feeding of solution a free available chlorine residual throughout the distribution system. Logistical sampling must be conducted at the National Interim Primary Drinking Water Sampling Program with a DPD chlorine test kit. Contact your local Health Department for more information.

**DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING:**  
 Clean equipment in the normal manner. Rinse thoroughly with this sodium hypochlorite solution. After contact with disinfectant for 15 minutes, rinse thoroughly with one fluid oz (2 tbsps) of this solution per gallon of water. Provide approximately 200 ppm available chlorine. NOTE: This product degrades rapidly as necessary, to obtain the required concentration. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in original container, away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, clean up thoroughly by placing in trash collection or other suitable container. Do not contaminate food or feed.
