DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algi-Stat ER 30 is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of Algi-Stat ER 30 fluid ounces of Algi-Stat ER 30 of water to provide a concentration of 16 Algi-Stat ER 30 in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosage of Algi-Stat ER 30 Subsequent slug additions of 0.47 Algi-Stat ER 30 per 1000 40 parts per million of Algi-Stat ER 30 employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the summer months. Algi-Stat ER 30 is used for air-washing systems that maintain effective misting. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug dose of 7.1 Algi-Stat ER 30 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Repeat initial dosage of 4.8 to 11.9 fluid ounces of Algi-Stat ER 30 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions may be made in the summer months. Algi-Stat ER 30 is used for collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be removed from service and placed in a secondary container for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a secondary container. Containers should be closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this pesticide should be disposed of at a government approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:
