### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**IN NON-RESIDENTIAL FOOD HANDLING AREAS:** Use in food processing plants, schools, taverns, grocery stores, hotels, motels, bottling plants, canneries, bakeries, cafeterias, hospitals, and restaurants.

**TAVERN PESTS, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOths, Gnats, Wasps:** Spray light on floor in center of area to be treated. Spray in a circular pattern of container. When discharge of insecticide is complete, close lid as possible and leave closed for at least 24 hours. Repeat as necessary. The entire contents of this container will treat approximately 1000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Do not use in areas where people are present after treatment is completed.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Do not use or store near heat, open flame, or other sources of ignition.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty containers. Dispose of in accordance with local, state, or federal collection.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT - HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Irritates skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if swallowed.

Avoid contamination of feed and food. Do not use in food processing plants. Food should be removed from food processing surfaces should be removed and cleaned before using. When using this pesticide, the facility is not in operation. Remove people before spraying.

**NOTE:** When used in hospitals, patients should be removed and wait two hours before patients are present.
