TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thick newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks, start fogging action. Set canister in upright position and etc. and leave building at once. **DO NOT ENTER** built up FOG FOR ONE HOUR then open exterior doors and windows and air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS: Destroy old pet beds, replace. Use product as above. Treat dog's and cats with tick control product prior to re-entry.
