1) Change the Ingredient Statement to read:

ACTIVE INGREDIENT	
DEET.....	98.11%
OTHER INGREDIENTS.....	1.89%

2) Add the following statements to the Precautionary Statements:

“ Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes .”

3) Delete references to 100% DEET from the label.

A stamped copy of the amended label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the final label before the product is released for shipment under this revised label.
