STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting.  
Consult a physician.

If On Skin: May cause skin reactions in  
rare cases. If so, wash  
thoroughly with plenty of  
soap and water. Get medical  
attention if irritation  
persists.

If In Eyes: Wash with plenty of water.  
Get medical attention if  
irritation persists.

e. Delete the term "General Classification."

3. Item 17 on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 8, 1990 shows 100 pounds; however, the total of each individual item adds up to only 97.9 pounds. Submit a revised CSF which contains the correct amounts and percentages in columns 13.a. and 13.b.


4. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this Registration Notice.

5. Submit information regarding the corrosion characteristics of this product. This information can be noted during the storage stability study.

6. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
