The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments:

1. Add the statement "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you." to the Directions for Use.
2. Add the statement "Do not spray in enclosed areas." to the Directions for Use.
3. Delete the statement "Do not allow children to rub their eyes if hands have been treated." from the Precautionary Statements. This information contradicts the Directions for Use to "not apply to the hands of young children."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed. Submit three copies of revised final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.

The confidential statements of formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation and the three confidential statements of formula for alternate formulations (dated July 11, 1996) have been added to the product file and supersede all previously submitted confidential statements of formula for this product.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read all Directions and Precautionary Statements Before Using This Product

Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overexposure. Do not use under clothing. Do not spray directly on face. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Repeat as needed. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames and fabric such as acetate and rayon.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Causes eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Do not allow children to rub their eyes if hands have been treated. Instruct older children in the proper use of this product.
