If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Move the following statement to the directions for use:
do not spray in enclosed areas.

Delete the following sentence:
Do not allow children to rub their eyes if hands have been treated.


Delete the reference to spray every 48 hours, as this direction was not supported by the efficacy data.

Modify the sentence about human consumption to read:
Do not use on horses intended for slaughter.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read all Directions and Precautionary Statements Before Using This Product

[Human Use Directions:]

Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Avoid overexposure. Do not use under clothing. Do not spray directly on face. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Repeat as needed. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames and fabric such as acetate and rayon.

[Equine Use Directions:]

To repel the insects listed on the front panel, hold sprayer 6 to 12 inches from animal and spray on the areas where insects are observed. To apply to face, spray on a clean cloth and rub on. Apply in early morning or at dusk for best results. Repeat every 24 to 48 hours or as directed by a veterinarian. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Do not apply other insecticides or repellents when using this product. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply under wraps or bandages. Do not apply to eyes and mouth. Do not spray directly on face. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames and fabric such as acetate and rayon. Do not use on animals intended for human consumption.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
