Dear Mr. Dickens:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

<u>Directions for Use, {For equine use product packaged in a pump spray:} section comment(s):</u>

- 1. Incorporate the following changes:
 - Within the 11th sentence, replace the word "on" with the word "onto"
 - Within the 13th sentence, replace the word "reuse" with the words "wearing it again"
 - Within the 20th sentence, insert the word "repellent" immediately preceding the word "product"

Storage and Disposal section comment(s):

2. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4, revise the "Pesticide Disposal:" subsection to read "Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Offer for recycling if available, or place in trash. If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down and indoor or outdoor drain."

Precautionary Statements, Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals section comment(s):

3. Within both subsections of this section, revise the 2nd sentence to read "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

Optional Marketing Statements section comment(s):

- 4. Within optional marketing statement #7, replace the word "Includes" with the word "Contains"
- 5. Within optional marketing statement #13, replace the words "Specially formulated with" with the word "Contains"

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA.
