

DIRECTIONS FOR USE


It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. READ AND FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS ON THIS PRODUCT **LABEL.** Apply this product only as specified on this label. Hold container 6 to 8 inches from exposed skin and/or clothing with a slow, sweeping motion. DO NOT spray in enclosed areas. Avoid breathing a spray product, and DO NOT use it near food. Repellents should be applied only to exposed skin and/or clothing (as directed on this product label), DO NOT use under clothing. Never use repellents over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Use just enough of this product to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Heavy application and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. For maximum protection, spread evenly with hand to moisten all exposed skin. If biting insects do not respond to a thin film of repellent, apply a bit more. 
