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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hold 4 to 6 inches away from skin while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Avoid over-application of this product. 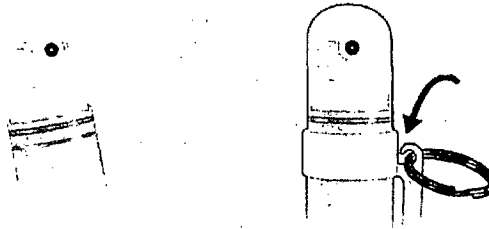
