DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Repels listed insects and ticks for up to eight hours. Hold 4 to 6 inches away from skin while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin. Avoid over-application of this product. Do not apply to the hands of small children. Do not use under clothing. Do not spray directly on face. Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palms of hands and spreading on face and neck. Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin. Reapply every 8 hours. Do not exceed two applications per day.


