An initial slug addition of 5.1 CQ 1410-B per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is established. Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 CQ 1410-B per 1000 gallons

every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency, relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bleedoff additions should be made in the sump of water

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
