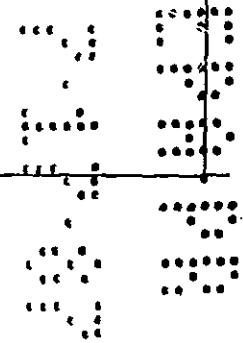

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish apply one or two bait stations per room, placing the bait tube stations under and behind the refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs, near drains, water pipes, electrical conduits, along baseboards, in cabinets, closets, cupboards, kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers, chests of drawers, bookshelves, patios, carports, garages, and in sewers and manholes.

Bait tube stations should be replaced as necessary. Any portion of the product that is visible should be brushed into newspaper and placed in trash. Bait tube stations should be placed so as to be inaccessible to children or pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING IN NEW CONSTRUCTION TO CONTROL COCKROACHES: When treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction place bait tube stations as deemed necessary using adhesive stickers to secure as desired.

This product may be used in homes, restaurants, and other food and feed handling establishments, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theatres, ships, boats, trains, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

FOOD AND FEED HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS - Places other than private residences in which exposed food or feed is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREA-APPLICATION OF BAIT TUBE STATIONS LIMITED

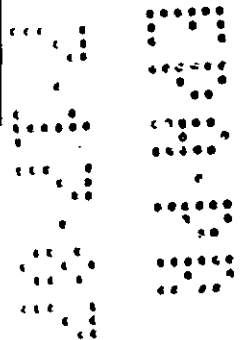
