PRECAUTIONS IN THE USE OF OIL INCLUDE: Do not apply oil spray when trees are wilting. Do not apply oil and sulfur within 3 weeks of each other. Oil spray applied after October 1 may increase susceptibility of trees to cold damage and may reduce the fruit crop the following year. Oil sprays applied in the fall may inhibit solids formation in the juice and retard coloring of fruit, and should not be applied within 60 days of anticipated harvest. ### FRUIT AND SHADE TREES

APPLES, PEARS, PEACHES, CHERRIES, etc. (1.5 gals./50 gals. of water) to control scale insects. Spray thoroughly, wetting.

OAKS, ELM, WILLOWS, BASSWOOD, etc. Do not use on Maples, Mountain Ash (S).

PRECAUTIONS: Do not spray within 30' of broadleaved evergreens when temperatures may cause discoloration of Blue Spruce. Follow quickly or when temperature is below point before the spray has thoroughly label and follow all cautions.

### ORNAMENTAL PLANTS

ORNAMENTAL PLANTS (Azaleas, Camellias, Evergreens, Hardy Shrubs):

Scale Insects, Spider Mites, and Whiteflies when infestations first appear, repeat at 7-10 day intervals.

AZALEAS and CAMELLIAS: Apply in spring after blooming and in fall before anticipated freeze. Spray for evergreen.

AVOCADO: Avocado Red Mites - 3 quarts per 100' Florida Red Scale, Avocado Whitefly, P. Apply when infestations first appear.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not use more than 1 gallon per 100' under certain circumstances. Do not use after using Sulfur or Captan. Do not use applications, nor use more than twice plants weakened from any cause whether cold or freeze damage, recent root pruning or plants when temperatures are excessive motion while spraying. Do not overlap
