DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this bandana in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Add two drops of the active ingredient from the bottle to the cotton seam of the bandana. Tie the herballly scented bandana loosely around dog's neck, rolling to size. To insure that the bandana is not too tight while tying, insert two or three fingers between bandana and dog's neck. The bandana will immediately begin to repel fleas present on animal and will help prevent fleas from reappearing. The bandana will continue this action for a month or more. When bathing dog, remove scarf and return to neck when dog is dry. This bandana may be worn with a regular collar.

A 2 oz. bottle of blended ^{Herbal} PENNINOVA OIL is attached to aid in keeping the essential "mint" scent fresh. After each laundering or every 7 days, apply 2 or 3 drops of oil to thickened area of the long seam.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by Storage or Disposal.

STORAGE: Store in cool, dry place away from heat and sunlight.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container and used bandana in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
