Hand Sanitizing—In food handling and meat cutting operations: Rinse hands and immerse in a 1 oz. DAN IO-10 per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

Retort Cooling Water—For canning operations—add 1 oz. DAN IO-10 per 5-10 gallons of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization—1 oz. DAN IO-10 per 10 gallons of drinking water.

Shoe Bath Sanitizer—To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of DAN IO-10 for 30 seconds prior to entering area.

Precautionary Statements

DANGER


