CUNAPWRAP containing copper naphthenate is intended for use only on poles, posts and pilings as a wood preservative treatment. CUNAPWRAP containing copper naphthenate provides protection against all stages of fungal rot, termite damage, and copper naphthenate is preservative, protective and seal wood surfaces that will be in contact with soil, concrete. Depending upon climate conditions, species of wood to which applied, moisture and humidity, treatment materials service life several years.

PREPARATION AND APPLICATION

Wood should be clean, dry, well seasoned and free of bark. When using CUNAPWRAP as a groundline treatment, excavate around wood to allow top of wrap to extend 2" above groundline.

Protect eyes and skin from contact.

Wire brush area 3" above groundline and approximately 20" below groundline removing dirt and decayed material.

LIN CUNAP WRAP ~ from carton and lay flat on ground

Unfold, exposing plastic envelopes

Cut open front of plastic bags on all four edges, (as shown by dotted lines)

Exposing saturated pads

Avoid cutting through to backing



Wrap proper length CUNAP WRAP ~ around the pole with saturated pad against the pole and staple or tack firmly in place. Staple short side of the backing first and overwrap with longer edge. Allow wrap to extend 2" above groundline.
