HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

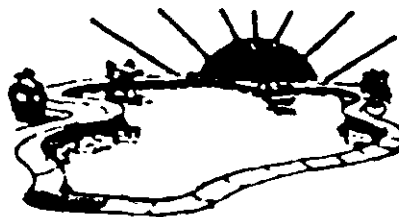
DANGER: Corrosive. Causes severe skin irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING

For a new pool or for spring start-up (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution per gallon of water. This dosage is adjusted by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6-7.8
B) Add manually or by a feeder device hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain 0.5 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (100 ml) of hypochlorite solution for each 50,000 gallons of water. Maintain 0.5 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine. Chlorine concentration and number of swimmers, water temperature and chlorine residual are in the label.

NOTE: This product degrades with increase dosage. As necessary, to obtain chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood with water. Rinse empty container thoroughly to manufacturer or discard by placing in approved land fill. Product or rinse diluted with water and disposed of in same manner as waste. Do not store in same place as food or feed by storage, disposal.
