DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL

For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for 5000 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.2 range and maintain sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water. Maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequently maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine with sodium hypochlorite solution. Use test kit to determine chlorine residual and number of swimmers.
