

DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WS-50 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and indoor effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of WS 50 fluid ounces of WS 50 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of WS 50 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly installed hot tub or decorative fountain, add initially 0.7 fluid ounces of WS 50 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For decorative fountains, add initially 0.3 to 0.5 fluid ounces of WS 50 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of WS 50 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

WS-50 is compatible with chlorine chemicals used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains. Do not use on alkaline pH. WS-50 is compatible with chlorine chemicals used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored away from food. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Vapors should be kept away from food.
