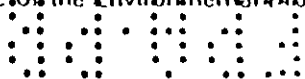

DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WS-60 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tub effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. A heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of WS-60 per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools with algae, add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of WS-60 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of WS-60 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains should be treated with WS-60. Require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of WS-60 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly installed hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of WS-60 per 1,000 gallons of water.

WS-60 is compatible with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix WS-60 with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in plastic and dispose of with clear water.
