This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA Section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7) and the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

(a) Add the phrase "EPA Reg. No. 54543-1".

(b) The ingredients statement of the dispenser label should appear on the front panel. Space for this relocation may be made by moving the company address to the end of the label. The terms "Ingredients:" and "Total 100.0%" may be deleted if there is insufficient space available on the front panel. NOTE: There should be a hyphen between "2,2" and "Dichlorovinyl" in the formula name appearing on both labels.

(c) Relocate "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" to appear above the signal word "CAUTION" on both labels.

(d) The dispenser label should refer the user to the box label for use directions (i.e. "Refer to box label for directions for use").

(e) Insert "le" between "etiqueta" and "haya" in the "PRECAUCION AL USUARIO".

(f) A Statement of Practical Treatment may be added to the box labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise you may choose to revise the specific advice or to delete advice pertaining to any avenue of potential exposure which test data has demonstrated to be in Toxicity Category IV for this specific formulation.

[NOTE - similar first aid advice currently presented in the box label's "Hazards to Humans" section could then be deleted. The "Note to Physician" should appear directly under the Statement of Practical Treatment.]

(g) Delete "USE DIRECTIONS" under the heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" and close up existing text.

(h) Revise the "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" text to appear as follows:

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.  
Do not remove dispenser cap or foil seal before installation.  
Do not reuse container. Wrap used container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection.

(1) You may choose to delete the block with CAUTION and the exclamation points and instead just use the word "Caution" under the subheading "HAZARDS TO HUMANS". [NOTE - there is no minimum type size requirement for the signal word when it appears at this location on the label.]

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling and minimum type size requirements for certain label elements.
4. Results of a one-year storage stability study for this specific formulation must be submitted within eighteen months of the date of this Notice. You have indicated that such a study is currently underway and have agreed in writing (January 31, 1986) to submit the results of this study.
5. Results of efficacy studies to support the pest control claims for this product must be submitted within 90 days of the date of this Notice. You have indicated that results of such studies are currently available and have agreed in writing (January 31, 1986) to submit the results of these studies.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The submitted product specific chemistry data is acceptable and has been assigned Accession Number 258737. Please refer to this Accession Number in any future correspondence concerning this specific data submission. It is understood that the supplier will confirm the concentration of the technical dichlorvos to be used in the formulation of this product.

The toxicity and dichlorvos concentration studies submitted with your application have been assigned Accession Number 258738. The dichlorvos concentration study is adequate to address potential inhalation exposure. The other studies submitted are supplementary in nature and would not have been required by the Agency.
