The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.


The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Copper Compounds Amended Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. Pursuant to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6) you must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. See FIFRA section 2(p)(2). If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process, FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(B). Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. When your pool is not being used for swimming, such as vacation times and winter lay-ups, Kleen Pool will keep your pool clear and free of most algae without the use of other chemicals.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DOSAGE RATES: One six month treatment: 1 Quart of Kleen Pool Algicide per 5,000 gallons of pool water. To calculate volume for rectangular pools, multiply length x width x average depth x 7.5. For oval pools, multiply long diameter x short diameter x average depth x 5.9. For round pools, multiply diameter x diameter x average depth x 5.9. When algae reappears, then a further treatment is necessary. Kleen Pool Algicide Level should be maintained between 0.2 and 2.0 units as measured by a copper test kit. These test kits are available from your pool supplier.

APPLICATION: Kleen Pool Algicide comes concentrated. Pour Kleen Pool directly into pool. Maintain continuous pool circulation for at least eight hours after application.

IMPORTANT: Adjust your pool pH level to 7.2 before adding Kleen Pool. Maintain the pH level in the range of 7.2 to 7.6 to ensure maximum effectiveness. Kleen Pool Algicide is not for use in pools where the pH cannot be maintained in the 7.2 to 7.6 range. Badly scaled pools may cause elevated pH conditions above the recommended range. Pools with scale should be de-scaled before using Kleen Pool.

This product may not be compatible with other algaecides-check with manufacturer before use. Kleen Pool Algicide must not be mixed with other chemicals and should be added directly to the pool water as instructed above. Refer to the "Understanding Kleen Pool" booklet for more detailed information.
