

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

**FIRST AID:** If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with these directions.

Winterzine is used to control the growth of algae in whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains. For maximum effectiveness, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains containing algae should be cleaned prior to using Winterzine.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of Winterzine per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settling material. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 9 to 17 fluid ounces of Winterzine per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Winterzine per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains having visible algae require an initial dose of 17 to 26 fluid ounces of Winterzine per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 9 to 17 fluid ounces of Winterzine per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 3 to 9 fluid ounces of Winterzine should be made every 5 to 7 days for maintenance.

Winterzine algaecide will prevent growth of most algae in pools for 6 to 8 months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been treated during swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 72 to 108 fluid ounces of algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of swimming season there is visible algae growth, add 140 to 206 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons for uniform distribution of algaecide throughout the water and maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to re-treat more times during the season.

Winterzine is compatible with those chemicals normally used in pools, spas, and decorative fountains and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. The amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not use concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and disposed of with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of sight and away from food.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in plastic and dispose of with clear water.
