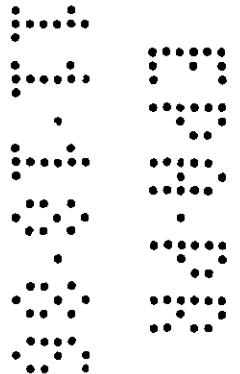

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The BRITA WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK may be used to disinfect untreated water under the conditions set forth below. Under no conditions is the WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK to be used to process raw water unless the disinfectant enclosed herein is used as directed.

Using a suitable container filled with water to be disinfected, place in the water one (1) tablet of the disinfectant for each quart of water. Allow to stand for ten minutes per quart of water to be certain that disinfection has occurred.

When the water is disinfected insert the filter cartridge into the neck of the white plastic collar or funnel. Then place the collar or funnel over a clean separate container and pour the disinfected water through the filter.

Used as directed the WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK will remove the chemical taste of the disinfectant, the suspended dirt or sediment in the water, along with any turbidity that may be in the water.

Be certain to read carefully the DIRECTIONS FOR USE that are enclosed herein for the disinfectant and that are also found on the label of the disinfectant bottle. Do not use hot water. Always use water from the cleanest possible source.

The cartridge within the BRITA WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK is able to filter at least 50 gallons of water. You should calculate to replace the cartridge about once a month under normal use. You may notice that the water processing through the filter is not as fresh and tasteful as usual. It will then be time to put in a new cartridge. Cartridges can be obtained from the same dealer that supplied your filter.

If used as directed the result will be water suitable for cooking or human consumption.

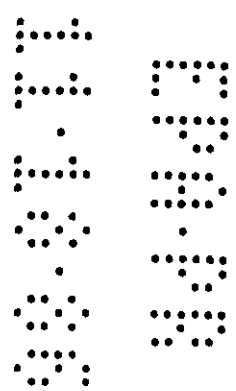

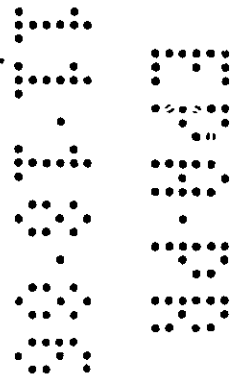
