- b. Revise the subheading "Contents" to read as follows:
"Net contents: One Bacteriostatic Water Filter Cartridge including one plastic funnel and one bottle of Portable Aqua Tablets".
- c. Delete the phrase "inhibits the growth of bacteria within the filter" from the ingredient statement.



Submit one copy of final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use with cold water only.

This product inhibits the growth of bacteria in the filter to prolong the life of the filter.

The BRITA WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK may be used to disinfect untreated water under the conditions set forth below. Under no conditions is the filter to be used to process raw water unless the disinfectant enclosed in this carton is used as directed.

Using a suitable container filled with water to be disinfected, add one (1) disinfectant tablet for each quart of water. Allow to stand for ten minutes per quart of water to be certain that disinfection has occurred.

After the water is disinfected, insert the filter cartridge into the neck of the white plastic collar or funnel. Then place the collar or funnel over a clean separate container and pour the disinfected water through the filter.

When used as directed, the BRITA WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK will remove the chemical taste of the disinfectant, the suspended dirt or sediment in the water, along with any turbidity that may be in the water.

Be sure to carefully read the enclosed DIRECTIONS FOR USE for the disinfectant, which are also found on the label of the disinfectant bottle. Always use water from the cleanest possible source.

The filter cartridge in the BRITA WATER FILTER TRAVEL PAK is able to filter at least 35 gallons of water. You should replace the filter every 35 gallons or 2 months, whichever comes first. When the filtered water is not as fresh tasting as usual, it will be time to replace the filter.
