To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, ryegrass, wildoats, crabgrass, cheatgrass, broomsedge, ragweeds, lambsquarter and turkey mullein, dilute one gallon of Concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply 5 gallons of the diluted spray, per 1000 square feet.
