

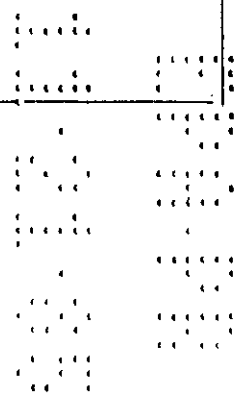

The new Aqua-King bacteriostatic water filter improves the taste of drinking tea, soups, beverages and ice cubes. The Aqua-King bacteriostatic water filter removes bad taste, chlorine, sediment, odor and filters up to 4,000 gallons of municipal water depending on local water quality and chlorine content. REPLACEMENT: The Aqua-King water filter should be replaced after approximately 4,000 gallons or when reduction in flow is noticed, or detection of taste and odor or chlorine reappears in the filtered water.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Locate & turn off the cold water line under sink by turning valve clock-wise.
2. Either cut in tee and valve or use tapping valve to supply 1/2 inch copper tubing to inlet connection to Aqua-King Bacteriostatic Water Filter.
3. Mount dispensing water fountain on top surface of sink through existing or drilled 1/2 inch hole.
4. Connect 1/2 inch brass unions and tubing to outlet filter to inlet faucet under sink.
5. Turn on cold water supply valves and flush lines 5 to 10 minutes to expell air and carbon fines.
6. Your new Aqua-King Bacteriostatic Water Filter is now ready to enjoy.
