

It is a violation of federal law inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR

FOR A NEW POOL OR FOR SPRING (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for every 10,000 gallons of water. This dosage is by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.2-7.6.

B) Add manually or by a feed system. Add sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half gallon of sodium hypochlorite solution for every 10,000 gallons of water. Maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine at all times. Adjust the rate and number of swimmers and chlorine residual are in accordance with the label.

NOTE: This product degrades in sunlight. Increase dosage, as necessary, to maintain chlorine residual.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, absorb with water. Rinse empty container with water. Do not reuse. Return to manufacturer or discard by an approved land fill. Product diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary manner. Do not feed by storage.
