An initial slug addition of 1.5 \_\_\_\_\_ per 1000 gallons is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Subsequent slug additions of 0.5 \_\_\_\_\_ per 1000 gallons

every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store more than five drums high.
