For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial 6 fluid ounces of Algaecide II to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of Algaecide II per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Algaecide II per 10,000 gallons should be made 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0 Algaecide II per 1,000 gallons of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of A should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. Algaecide II is composed used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains alkaline pH. Algaecide II decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
